Subject: Great job on the widening of the Fort Roots Highland Perimeter Trail!

Dear Mayor Smith and Bob,

Wow!! Late this afternoon I rode the Fort Roots Highland Perimeter Trail for the first time since completion of the trail widening project. The formerly dangerously narrow section is now wide enough for bicyclists, joggers and walkers to safely pass even if there are two trail users going side by side in opposite directions (in effect four side by side total). Plus the appearance of that section of the trail is greatly improved. I was surprised to find that the improvements to that section of the trail also significantly enhanced the overall quality of the trail use experience from one end of the trail to the other. I predict that the improvements will substantially increase use of the trail. The quality of the work on the trail was excellent. I took some photos and BACA will send an announcement of the completion of the project to the one-thousand plus people on the BACA e-mail list together with a before and after photo comparison.
