ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MID-YEAR 2015 QUOTA ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE NO. 8750) FOR THE NORTH LITTLE ROCK FIRE DEPARTMENT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council is responsible for establishing the number of employees in each department; and

WHEREAS, the North Little Rock Fire Department has received a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") of the Department of Homeland Security (Grant No. DMW-2014-FH-00131) to fund twenty-four (24) Firefighter positions for two (2) years (three [3] years for any veteran hired).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Section 15 of Ordinance No. 8750, adopted July 13, 2015, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 15: That the Fire Department shall consist of one hundred seventy five (175) full-time employees (172 uniformed and 3 non-uniformed) as follows: (Per Ordinance 7615, 1/26/04, is authorized to exceed by 3 the quota of firefighters due to absences caused by military leaves.)

Uniformed:

Chief, NEG - 1
Assistant Chief, Y04 - 1
Battalion Chief, Y04 - 3
Captain, Y03 - 42
Fire Marshall, Y04 - 1
Firefighter, Y01 - ~~57~~ 81 Add 24 positions - grant-funded 2-3 years depending on status of grant
Lieutenant, Y02 - 43

Non-uniformed:

Administrative Secretary, F06A - 1
Office Assistant, Senior, F05A - 1
Vehicle General Foreman, F10 - 1

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3: That the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, phrase or provision shall be declared or held invalid, such

invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the sections, phrases or provisions.

SECTION 4: That the City Council has determined that the interests of the City and City employees can best be served by the adoption of this ordinance; THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


